SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA & REQUIREMENTS

- Do not hold any CMSRL License
- Must meet the minimum entry requirement for Capstone Programme
- Have an agreement with the CMSL company to practice financial planning and provide advisory services
- Pass the RFP / Shariah RFP Capstone Programme (Examination and Project Paper) within one year from class intake
- Be licensed as a CMSRL upon meeting the licensing requirement set by SC, including passing the professional programme (RFP/Shariah RFP Capstone)

ENTRY REQUIREMENT FOR CAPSTONE

- Have a minimum of 3 years' full-time working experience in a financial-related industry **AND**
- Have a relevant PhD, Masters or Bachelor's degree, or
- Hold a CFP, CIPP (Part 1), RFP, Shariah RFP, or
- Be a member of MIA, MICPA, CFA (Aust.), ACCA, Bar Council, ICSA, MAICSA, CIMA
