Appoint ONE (1) point of contact (PIC) to assist the trainer 2. Secure a suitable training venue 3. Arrange meals for participants (morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea; optional) 4. Submit registration template to MFPC (template to be provided by MFPC) 5. Share learning materials provided by MFPC with participants prior to the training 6. Monitor class attendance on both Day 1 and Day 2 <p>Roles of MFPC:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Appoint trainer 2. Provide e-learning materials (e-books, e-lecture slides and e-practice questions) to ITO to be shared with participants 3. Administer examination related matters that include constructing, formatting and printing of examination questions, preparing of answer sheets, appointing invigilator (1 invigilator = 40 pax), verifying examination attendees, invigilating, marking, result tabulation, analysis and approval 4. Release of results to ITO (within 5 working days after the examination date) 5. Issue certificate of completion to participants (within 10 working days after the examination date) 6. Submit results to LIAM / MTA for regulatory reporting purposes

Programme Fee and Capacity The standard programme fee is RM12,000 for up to 100 participants; for groups exceeding 100, the fee is RM24,000 for up to 500 participants; and RM30,000 for up to 1,000 participants 2. Class and Examination Dates ITO to determine the dates, time slots, regions; MFPC remains flexible and is able to accommodate Saturday classes 		

3. Appointed Trainers

The certified trainers appointed by MFPC are highly experienced industry professionals, well-versed in the Module 2 syllabus and exam scope; they will be strategically positioned across Malaysia in alignment with ITO schedules

4. Digital Learning Materials:

Participants will receive comprehensive digital learning materials, which include e-books, e-lecture slides, and e-practice questions, available in both English and Mandarin (PITA M2) / English and Bahasa Malaysia (PITA Shariah M2) to cater to diverse learning needs. To facilitate effective revision and ease of reference, particularly on Day 2 of the programme, participants are to bring a printed copy of the practice questions.

5. Class Structure (2-day format):

Day 1: Instructional Class

Day 2 (morning): Revision Session

Day 2 (afternoon): Examination

6. Resit Policy:

A fee of RM200 will be imposed for physical resit examinations, which will be conducted in dual languages (English and Mandarin for PITA M2; English and Bahasa Malaysia for PITA Shariah M2). For virtual resit examinations, the MFPC PITA Resit Exam Policy applies, offering unlimited free resits until 31 May 2026 and two (2) complimentary resit attempts thereafter. Once the two complimentary resits have been fully utilised, a fee of RM100 per attempt will be charged.

7. Exam Administration:

Examination papers will be printed by MFPC

Invigilators will be appointed by MFPC

8. Proven Success

The physical classes consistently yield high pass rates (80% to 100%); attendee feedback has been overwhelmingly positive, reinforcing this as an effective and preferred mode of learning

9. Certificate of Completion:

Will be issued within 10 working days from the date of the examination
