EMPLOYEES PROVIDENT FUND (ACCOUNT II) EDUCATION WITHDRAWAL SCHEME FOR REGISTERED FINANCIAL PLANNING (RFP) AND SHARIAH REGISTERED FINANCIAL PLANNING (SHARIAH RFP) PROGRAMME

We are pleased to inform that the RFP and Shariah RFP professional programmes are now listed under the EPF (Account II) Education Withdrawal Scheme.

Members who wish to withdraw their EPF savings to finance their RFP or Shariah RFP course must possess at least a Bachelor Degree (Pass) or equivalent for their application to be approved. Members must also ensure that they complete all the relevant forms and fulfill all conditions required for their application for education financing to be approved.

MFPC Guidelines on Employees Provident Fund (EPF) Withdrawal Scheme

This scheme allows Employees Provident Fund (EPF) members to withdraw from Account II to pay the programme fees.

- **Eligibility Conditions**
 - Malaysians
 - Below 55 Years of age
 - Savings available in Account 2

- **Payment and Reimbursement**

Members who choose to settle programme fees using their own fund may subsequently submit a claim for reimbursement under the EPF Account II withdrawal scheme.

- **Procedure:**
 - **Payment:** Remit the programme fees to MFPC using personal funds.
 - **Document Preparation:**
 - Completed Form KWSP 9H (AHL) and checklist
 - Copy of identification documents (originals required for verification if non-MyKad holder)
 - Student enrolment confirmation letter
 - Course fee receipt
 - EPF approval letter or email (issued by EPF to MFPC)
 - **Submission to EPF:** Submit all supporting documents to the nearest EPF branch for processing.
 - **Reimbursement:** EPF will verify the submission and reimburse the eligible amount from Account II directly to the member.
